

Do you qualify for a discount on your bill?

Oregon Lifeline is a federal and state government program that provides a discount on phone (\$12.25) or high-speed internet (16.25) service for qualifying low-income households.

(See back for details.)

From February 1 - June 30, 2021, qualifying low-income households will receive an additional \$5.00 discount per month.

The Lifeline discount is limited to one per household, consisting of either phone (landline or wireless) or high-speed internet service.

Do I qualify?

Apply if you receive:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Medicaid
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Veterans or Survivors Pension
- Federal Public Housing Assistance, or
- Your total household income is at or below 135% of the federal poverty guidelines

Qualifying households on federally-recognized Tribal lands may be eligible for an additional discount of up to \$25.00 per month. Visit www.lifeline.oregon.gov for more information.

Proof of eligibility:

You may be required to provide proof that you qualify.
